Fuhrmann Auditorium



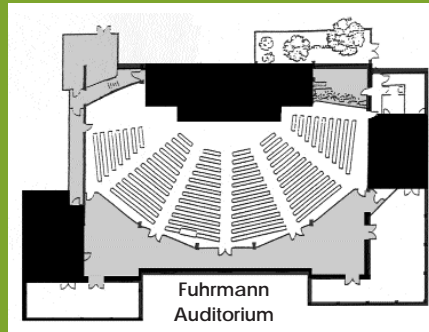
450 Seat Auditorium

The Fuhrmann Auditorium features a stage, a baby grand piano, dressing rooms, theatre lighting and sound system. The theatre is acoustically balanced and is centrally located within the center, with multiple entrances from the foyer.

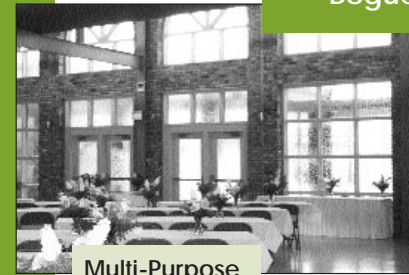

Guests will enjoy a private entry, use of the outside gazebo and ample parking.

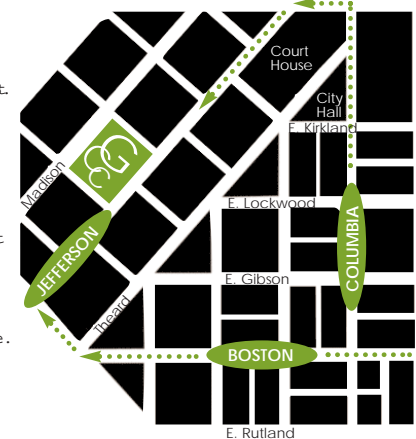
Historic Downtown Location
